USQ Ally Network

The USQ Ally Network aims to provide a safe and visible support network for all staff and students who may or may not identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex and queer (LGBTIQ) and/or have an interest in enhancing inclusion at USQ.



What is an Ally?

USQ Allies are staff and students from the USQ community who are informed about and empathetic to the needs of the LGBTIQ community. Allies do not necessarily identify as LGBTIQ and they are not necessarily professional counsellors or equity practitioners. Allies are advocates for a community free from harassment or discrimination based on sexuality and gender identity. They strongly support USQ's stance on inclusiveness and equity.

Allies can be identified by the small rainbow sticker on their door or window. They may also be wearing a small rainbow pin.

The aims of the USQ Ally Network

The USQ Ally Network aims to:

- Create a safe, supportive and inclusive educational and work environment
- Provide an open, confidential opportunity for students and staff to be listened to, and be understood

- Facilitate relevant and current referrals for students and staff to access further support when needed
- Create change and advocate against discriminatory or exclusive attitudes and behaviours.
